Fair play to them, their wide / no ball count was the same as ours, but their bowling lacked pace & their fielding & positioning was poor. Any loose ball was dispatched to the boundary, majority of them on the leg side. Numerous 2's & 3's were taken, so good running between the wickets. Ballington led the rout with his highest score in the league this year (33). A welcome return to form for Rappolt, Newton & Stoffer too. 9 of our 10 players made it comfortably to double figures - a welcome boost as we approach a top of the table clash V Hutton next weekend.
