Shenfield 130 all out (37.5 overs)

Horndon 131 for 4 (30.2 overs)

Horndon won by 6 wickets

Horndon outbatted Shenfield to record a comfortable 6 wicket win.

Shenfield, failed to put together any notable batting partnerships and posted a below par score of 130. The highest partnership was a mere 20 runs between Pearce (15) and Savill (38 not out). With the loss of wickets Savill went on the defensive. And with a low scoring rate the tail failed to wag as they unsuccessfully tried to accelerate. In total 6 batsmen holed out, a number of them succumbing to full tosses.

Horndon carried a long tail into the game and Shenfield came close to exposing them. Rickenbach applied pressure with his spin bowling, limiting Horndon to 11 off his 8 overs and taking 1 run. 2 wickets from Brooking and 1 from Pearce gave Shenfield a glimmer of hope. But Hammond steered Horndon to victory with 30 not out.
